Hunting Rules and Policies

Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission (LAWPC) properties accommodate a wide variety of public uses including but not limited to hiking, canoeing, cross-country skiing, scientific research, and hunting. In order to create a safe and enjoyable environment for all visitors, we ask hunters to review and comply with our hunting program rules and policies. Failure to adhere to the rules will result in suspension of hunting privileges or citation by law enforcement. Hunting Rules & Regulations

1. Hunters must possess a valid ME hunting license and comply with all applicable ME hunting regulations. Hunters must carry a current, signed **Landowner Courtesy Card** while hunting on any LAWPC property. This may be a digital copy.
2. Tree stands and game cameras may be used but must not be attached to trees with nails, screws, or anything that causes damage to the health of the tree. Stands must be removed no later than two weeks after the close of the season. If a stand is not removed by the owner, then it may be removed by LAWPC staff or a Maine Warden Service officer. No stands shall be placed within 100 feet of a property boundary or trail system.
3. LAWPC must have a record of location for all tree stands, game cameras, and traps, and all must be labeled with land user contact information. If undocumented, these items may be removed without notice.
4. No target shooting, practice, or gun ranges are permitted on LAWPC lands.
5. Hunting is allowed on assigned LAWPC properties only. Not every LAWPC property is open for public hunting. A property map is included in this packet for your reference.
6. Whitman Spring Road Tract: BOW HUNTING ONLY is permitted in this tract. This area is within the City of Auburn firearms discharge restricted zone. A map of the firearms discharge restricted zone is included in this packet for your reference. This Tract also hosts a multi-use trail that is heavily used. Please use caution to avoid user conflict.
7. There is no bodily contact allowed in Lake Auburn or the Basin or with the streams feeding into them.
8. Fires, camping, and dumping of waste are not permitted on LAWPC property.
9. Disturbing soils, vegetation, or rocks is not permitted on LAWPC property.
10. ATVs are not allowed on LAWPC property.
11. All other LAWPC property rules and regulations, local ordinances, and State laws must be followed at all times by all hunters.
12. All LAWPC hunting Tracts are open to multiple recreation uses. All hunters should be aware of other land users while hunting.

I have read, understand, and will comply with the LAWPC rules and policies. I understand that hunting and related activities involve inherent risk, and I assume all risk and therefore release the land owner, its officers, agents, and assignees from liability for injuries or damages and agree to indemnify and hold harmless the land owner against any claims.

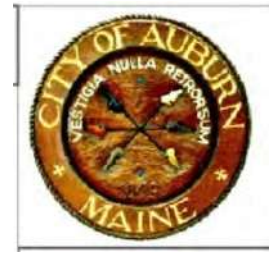

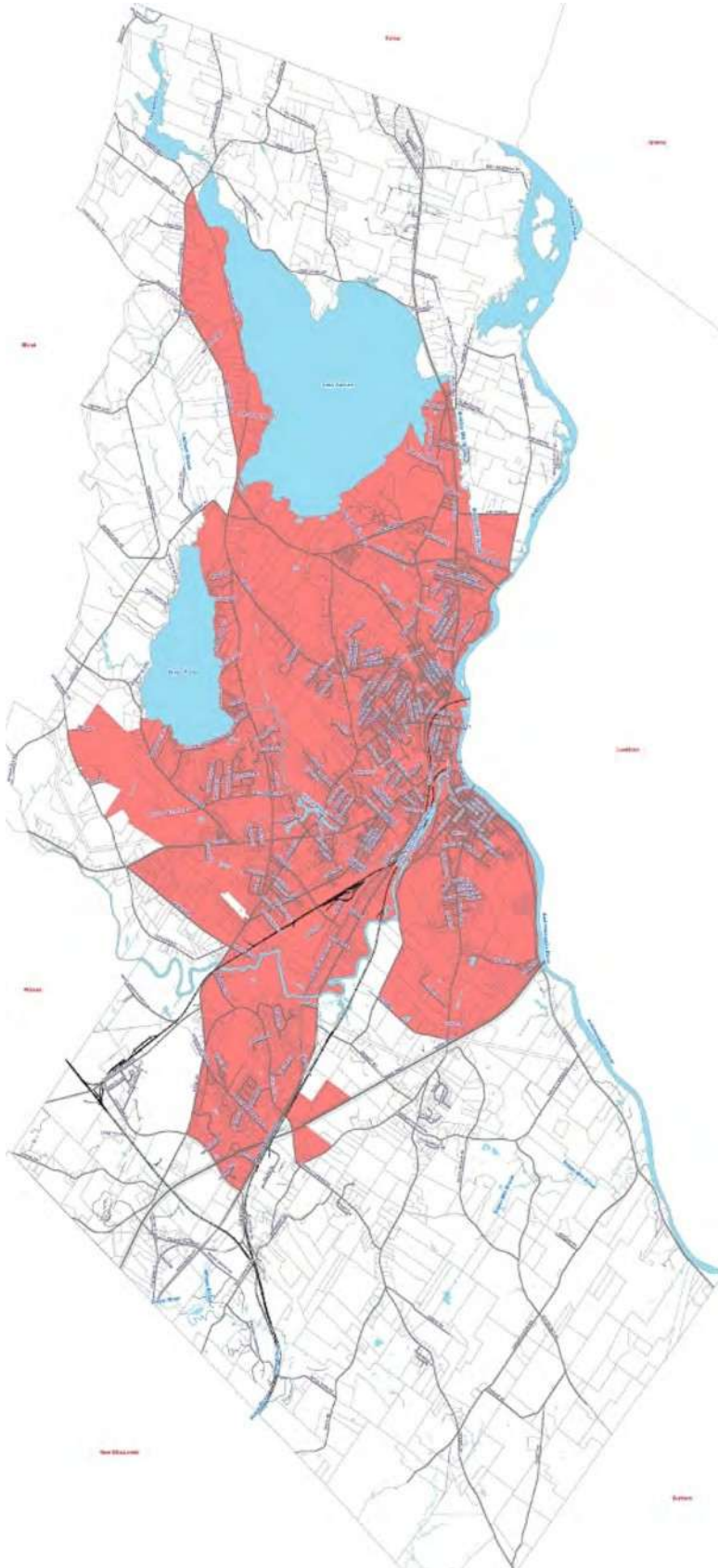
Firearms Discharge Restricted Zone
